Overview

INTRODUCTION



Still I Rise Academy (SIR) in Aden, Yemen, was established in October 2023 to provide accelerated education to 50 vulnerable children in Dar Saad.

These students, from displaced, refugee, and host communities, had little to no prior education.

By the end of the 2023-2024 academic year, **47 students completed the program**, passed their Ministry of Education exams, and enrolled in public schools for the 2024-2025 academic year!





Overview HUMANITARIAN CRISIS

Yemen has been in the throes of

conflict since 2014, leading to one of the world's most severe humanitarian crises. The conflict has displaced millions, with many children losing access to education.

Access to quality education is severely limited due to destroyed infrastructure, displaced populations, and economic hardship. Schools are often understaffed and lack basic supplies.

Challenges and Achievements EDUCATIONAL CHALLENGES

All our children were out of school and either refugees or internally displaced, victims of the ongoing civil war. **Most live in camps** and are picked up each day by Still I Rise's transport, a service we provide in all our sites.

Many children face psychosocial challenges from years out of school and unstable living conditions.

Students at the academy study essential subjects, including Arabic, Math, English, Science, and Art, while also engaging in activities like sports, chess, poetry, handicrafts, acting, and yoga.

Additionally, **they develop soft skills** such as leadership, critical thinking, creativity, problem-solving, questioning, negotiation, and debating.

52 STUDENTS enrolled in the programme (24M - 28F) **47 STUDENTS** completed the programme (23M - 24F)


