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## Overview INTRODUCTION

Still I Rise Ma'an Academy in Syria has been a transformative space for vulnerable children, helping them transition into public and private schools while ensuring they are well-prepared for their academic journey.

The 2023-2024 cohort consisted of 80 students, many of whom had limited prior education or had been out of school for years.

By providing these children with both academic and psychosocial support, SIR facilitated their smooth enrollment into formal education systems.

## INTRODUCTION

On September 21st, 2024, most of the students from this cohort were enrolled in public schools, where their grade levels were determined based on non-governmental assessments.

For students who were unable to secure places in public schools, 12 children were accepted into private schools, thanks to financial support and discounts arranged by SIR.









#### **Challenges and Achievements**

## **EDUCATIONAL CHALLENGES**

Many students entering Still I Rise Academy were **refugees or internally displaced**, with inconsistent or no prior formal education. One of the greatest challenges was the **educational gap**, which, although not exceeding two years, still posed difficulties in crowded public schools that often hesitate to accept students with significant academic delays.

Additionally, psychosocial challenges, such as trauma from displacement and instability, needed to be addressed to ensure the children's mental well-being and ability to focus on their studies. SIR provided a nurturing environment where students could develop the confidence and resilience needed to overcome these barriers.





## Challenges and Achievements **ACHIEVEMENTS**

The cohort's greatest achievement is that 100% of the students were successfully enrolled in either public or private schools.

This is a testament to SIR's holistic approach, addressing not only academic readiness but also emotional and social development.

With the new academic year underway, the 80 transitioning students will continue their journey in public or private schools. SIR will remain an integral part of their support system by maintaining communication with the schools and families. This ongoing connection ensures the students' attendance, progress, and well-being are closely monitored throughout the year.

SIR will continue to support these students through various initiatives:



**School Kits:** Providing necessary supplies such as books, uniforms, and stationery to all students.



Ongoing Engagement: Staying in contact with the families and celebrating students' achievements at the end of each school year.



**Regular Visits to SIR:** Inviting students to return to the academy for mentorship, support, and community events throughout the year.

#### **KEY ACHIEVEMENTS**

The greatest success has been enrolling all students into schools, providing them with a new beginning in their educational journeys.

#### **PROUD MOMENTS**

Students like Khadeeja and Muhammed, who had no prior formal schooling, were able to enroll in grades suitable to their age with ease, highlighting the effectiveness of the preparatory work done by SIR.





## **KEY ELEMENTS OF SUCCESS**

The educational gap for these students did not exceed two years, making their integration into formal schools more feasible.

Despite overcrowded schools, students were accepted because they met the academic standards necessary for their respective grades.

Remarkable **59% improvement** across the four main focus subjects over the year:

**ARABIC - 58%** 

**ENGLISH - 57%** 

**MATHS - 35%** 

IT - 86%

Throughout the year, the children demonstrated significant growth in **responsibility**, **independence**, and **teamwork**.

Each student became aware of their duties and responsibilities within both academic and social settings.

## **CHALLENGES OVERCOME**

One of the most pressing challenges faced by SIR's Child Protection and Safeguarding team was bullying.

This was addressed through awareness sessions aimed at educating students about the harmful effects of bullying and the consequences of such behavior in school.


Additionally, challenges related to sexual education were tackled by providing safe and informed discussions to address students' curiosities in a healthy manner.
